CUSCO – COMMUNITY BASED TOURISM IN PATABAMBA – CUSCO

After leaving Cusco city we will see the crops growing in the fields, such as potatoes, corn and Andean cereal like kiwicha, Quinoa and Cañihua. As soon as we get to Patabamba we will receive a friendly Andean welcome.

This community is known for their dedication to the preservation of the iconographies of Andean textiles. After the welcome meeting with the settlers, they'll take us to the edge of a cliff of 800m, where we will have the best view of the Sacred Valley. On our way back we'll pick up different flowers and plants to dye our t-shirt. Then we'll see how they cook potatoes, haba beans, plantain, cheese, chicken and lamb with an ancient technic called Pachamanca.

After our meals we're going to take our bus back to Cusco with our t-shirt with different and beautiful colors.

- Prices are subject to change without previous notice.

- Accommodation “Casa de Habitantes”: Call home residents to the homes of the villagers, who are enabled rooms in the homes of the people, usually with the bathroom outside the room, no hot water.
- These prices are valid only for non-Peruvian citizens travelling with a valid passport and holding the Andean migration card, which is provided on the plane upon entering the country and sealed by the airport Immigration Services representative (Maximo 6 months stay).
- This tour is subject to a minimum number of passengers. Please call for further details.
- Tipping is not included on the tour and is at your discretion
- Temperatures and weather conditions in the Andes can vary considerably during the day, so we recommend taking layers of clothes that can easily be added or removed
- This tour can be strenuous, as it visits altitudes of over 14,000 feet above sea level
- The tour involves a number of early starts, considerable travel and changes in food and climate, so you'll need a healthy constitution and an adaptable state of mind
- Due to its nature the tour is not suitable for those with walking difficulties
